on our students.

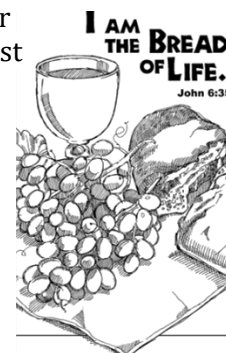
Help them to remain calm, to think clearly,

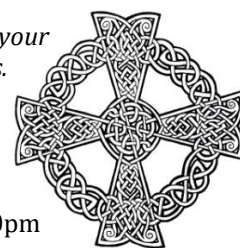
