

Sinking of the RMS Leinster

RMS Leinster was torpedoed and sunk by German submarine UB-123 on 10 October 1918. 564 people (crew, passengers and Postal Sorting Staff) were killed in the sinking near the Kish Lighthouse. Since the bombing of the GPO during Easter Week 1916, many of the postal sorters who were killed on board RMS Leinster had been doing shiftwork on the Mailboat to earn extra wages. This was the greatest loss of life ever in the Irish Sea and the highest death toll on an Irish-owned ship. Fr Robert attended a State Commemoration in Dun Laoghaire last Wednesday with relations of the deceased. As a parish community, we express our prayerful solidarity with the staff of **An Post** who took time at work last Wednesday to commemorate the deaths of their antecedents in 1918. We thank our local An Post staff for their ongoing work for our community and assure them of our prayers.
