To be loved as to love with all my soul.**

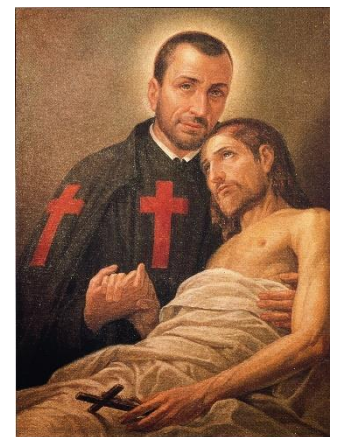
Make me a channel of your peace
