PREPARING TO GATHER AGAIN IN OUR CHURCHES

The reversal of the Government's decision to exempt churches from the limit of 50 persons indoors is deeply disappointing. We call on our public representatives to acknowledge the efforts being made by our Parish to ensure that parishioners can gather safely, and to seek fair treatment for the churches in line with other sectors of society. Over 100 people have generously volunteered to assist with social distancing, sanitizing, and disinfection measures in our churches.

IMPORTANT: Because of restrictions on the numbers attending, **we encourage parishioners to attend ONE Mass per week initially.** Please wear a facemask when attending Mass.

Yellow panelling and signs have guided our paths in every facet of life since March 2020. In preparing to gather together we have chosen to use an amber (traffic-light style) colour to signal our careful and gradual return to Mass with a congregation. We are also using the image of the dove with the olive branch which signalled the end of the flood. This meant that Noah and all in his care could return to a normal rhythm of life after being isolated for so long in the ark. A young artist in our parish has kindly interpreted this biblical image. She has added a set of bells (as you can see opposite) to represent the continual invitation which is given to the parish community. "The voice of prayer is never silent!" **Thank you all for following the signage and for respecting the guidance of our volunteers in both churches during the weeks ahead.**
